Wayne County Community Endowment Awards \$40,000 in Grants to 22 Local Food Pantries

The Wayne County Community Endowment has awarded \$40,000 in grants to 22 food pantries throughout Wayne County to assist local residents in need.

Based on data in a regional poverty report released by Rochester Area Community Foundation and ACT Rochester in December 2013, pantries located in areas with poverty rates higher than 15 percent received additional funding. The food pantries that received grants are:
