Two overarching goals drive our current competitive grantmaking — **creating an equitable community** and **strengthening our region's vitality**. This focus helps us and our community partners close achievement and opportunity gaps in city schools, foster racial understanding, and tackle the root causes and devastating impacts of poverty, as well as support the arts, preserve historical assets, and promote successful aging.

From April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017, the Community Foundation's board of directors approved the following competitive grants (categorized under the two main goals and each of their three action areas). Forever (unrestricted) and field of interest funds make possible most competitive grants.
