**GOAL: CREATE AN EQUITABLE COMMUNITY  
*Education Action Area***

Recommendations are supported by:

- *Community Impact Grant Fund*: Unrestricted fund for general charitable and educational purposes.

**Great Schools for All: Up to \$34,000**

Great Schools for All (GS4A) is looking to work with an external facilitator to build out a planning and implementation process that will create one to three economically and racially integrated magnet schools as a pilot for a more equitable educational system in Monroe County.

**GOAL: CREATE AN EQUITABLE COMMUNITY  
*Poverty Action Area***

Recommendations are supported by:

- *Sarah Collins Fund*: An estate gift from this retired Rochester Institute of Technology professor and community organization volunteer addresses the needs of oppressed and marginalized people.
- *Fund for Self Esteem*: Created after the sale of a local business, this fund supports projects that increase self-worth.

**Keuka Housing Council, Inc.: \$13,100**

The Hope Center serves as a hub of services for families experiencing food insecurity and serves as a referral point for families to access social services and other programming available in Yates County; this grant provides gap funding for the completion of the second phase to offer wraparound services.

**The Hub585: \$40,000**

The Life Launch program aims to provide hope, healing, and support to youth ages 13 to 18 who are in foster care through mentoring and life skills training.

**GOAL: STRENGTHEN REGIONAL VITALITY  
*Arts Action Area***

Recommendations are supported by:

- *Jazz Street Fund*: This fund was created by a challenge grant from a community philanthropist to support free public jazz performances during the Rochester International Jazz Festival.
- *Rodney Hatch Family Fund*: A charitable remainder trust established this fund to support the arts.

**Rochester International Jazz Festival: \$30,000**

Sponsorship of the 2022 Rochester International Jazz Festival's free outdoor stage that features many of our local high school jazz bands.
