Randy Freeland graduated from Palmyra Macedon Central School in 1982. He loved baseball and was named the Red Raider's MVP during his senior season. Randy continued his playing career at Finger Lakes Community College and then at the semi-pro level until the time of his death in 1990. In addition to being an outstanding baseball player, Randy was a hard worker and a thoughtful, considerate man who was well respected in the community.

The Randy Freeland Memorial Scholarship was established in 1990 and is presented to a Pal-Mac Senior Baseball Player for their accomplishments both on and off the field. The recipient of the Freeland Scholarship is selected by the founding committee as the individual that most exemplifies who Randy was. To be considered for the award a student must meet the following criteria: demonstrate an outstanding work ethic, academic record and athletic performance, contribute to the team and the community, and have a financial need.
