a host of other purposes.



Please accept this grant in memory of **Katie Harper**, a sixteen-year-old Fairport High School junior killed in a car accident in February 1994.

Katie ran on the track and cross-country teams. A few days before she died, she finished in second place in the 3,000-meter race and was a member of the first place 4x800 relay team. In the fall of 1993, Katie made the First Team All County for cross-country.

Katie loved music. She sang in Fairport's award-winning Polyphonic and Jazz Choirs, and was an accomplished pianist who played in recitals at Nazareth College annually.

Selected by her classmates, Katie became a member of the **Natural Helpers**--a group of teenagers who train to assist other students in resolving problems. Katie was the most active Natural Helper in her group.
